This internship is a **paid** position that may include credit hours as determined by the internship program guidelines of the respective college or university.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES

- Assist SAS in the *i play! afterschool* day-to-day program managements and the planning and execution of the Valero Volleyball Tournament, Basketball Tournament and Najim Tennis Tournament
 - Assist with the organization and management of equipment
 - Conduct specified coach communication
 - Manage uniform inventory and distribution for program
 - Assist with administrative functions as needed
- Assist in prepping for the Fit Family Challenge program and kick-off 5K
- Serve as event day staff in SAS events outside of the youth department such as the All-Star Football Game,
 Fiesta FitFest, and the Hall of Fame Tribute Gala
- Other duties/tasks as assigned.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will be a self-motivated individual with the ability to think outside the box and function well in a team environment. The intern should possess excellent verbal and written communication skills and can manage multiple projects and deadlines. This will be a hands-on position; the more the intern puts into the program, the more he/she can expect in return. The intern will be exposed to various areas of sports management and will have the opportunity to learn more about the marketing, program, and event management process that SAS executes in order deliver high quality events.
